

Irregular Words

Each iDeaL concept contains words that have an irregular sound or spelling, or a silent letter, meaning there is a less-direct correspondence between letters and sounds. Where applicable, they include exceptions to spelling rules.

The purpose of including the teaching of these, is to help students to further understand the concept and learn how to focus on all sounds and map the parts that don't follow phonology.

The teaching of these words will extend vocabulary and overall language comprehension, and it will further develop word attack skills for reading.


















How to use for independent practise:
